Hutson Gallery is pleased to announce the third summer exhibition in our fourth season featuring a duo show with recent paintings by Ellen Rolli and sculpture, copperplates and prints by Gay Malin.

Exhibiting for a fourth year with the Hutson Gallery, Gay Malin returns for a fourth season with bronzes and new work including sculpture of mixed media, linocuts and copperplates.

Gay's art reflects her interest in understanding the universe. As we try to understand our universe, String Theory has emerged as one possibility for the ultimate "Theory of Everything", a quest rooted in quantum physics theory. It basically states that all energy and matter is made up of tiny vibrating strings. Another aspect is that there are unobservable dimensions to the universe.

"These ideas have lead me to think about the world we inhabit in new and exciting ways. I have expanded on the idea of strings as a unifying element on a more human level, and the results are being shown in my current series titled 'String Theory'."

In addition, there are other works exploring our way of being in the universe with themes such as emergence "Primus Ordini", disintegration "Manus Deputo", and containment, "Boxed", "Framed" and "Masked".

Gay also works as a printmaker, exploring the same imagery and subjects through print and sculpted handmade papers. Malin received her education from Pratt Institute of Art, Brooklyn

Museum Art School, Syracuse University (B.F.A.), and University of Oregon, Eugene.

Gay Malin was a conservator for the New York State Museum in Albany and also exhibits at the at Martinez Gallery in Troy, NY, Riverfront Gallery in Schuylerville, NY and the Arkell Museum, Canajoharie, NY.
